Seller Terms & Agreement

June 11, 2011

The Marin Parents of Multiples Club (MPOMC) thanks you for your participation in our annual garage sale fundraiser. MPOMC looks upon this event not only as a fundraiser, but also as a service, allowing you to sell items for a greater return than at a regular garage sale or at a consignment store. We wish you great proceeds from your efforts in bringing your items to sell. In return, we ask for your understanding of the possible shortcomings of an event of this nature, including:

- Your price tags, though correctly applied, may come off during the sale, either accidentally in handling or purposefully by dishonest shoppers.
- Dishonest people may simply walk off with your items without paying for them.
- All wearable items will be sold at half price starting at 1pm on Saturday. If you do not want your non-wearable items sold at half price, draw a large red dot on both the upper and lower portion of the tag.
- Your unsold items may be incorrectly sorted at the end of the sale.

To help prevent these problems, MPOMC's policies stand as follows:

- Garage Sale Committee Members may price items brought to the checkout for purchase without a price tag. Any item we price over \$25 will be described in detail and noted so that we can attempt to find the seller of the item. Unclaimed items will be credited to the MPOMC account.
- A volunteer will monitor entrance and exit doors for sales security purposes. This can happen only if we have enough staff to handle checkout lines during the busiest sale hours.
- Any items you wish to be automatically donated at the end of the sale must be labeled with a yellow tag.
- A portion of a seller's proceeds will be contributed to MPOMC. The percentage of proceeds that a seller earns is based on the number of volunteer shifts worked during the sale.

Shifts Worked	Seller's Net Proceeds
0	50%
1	60%
2	70%
3	80%

- Any white-tagged items not picked up between 4:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. on Saturday will be donated and a \$50 fee will be charged to the seller.
- The Club will deduct \$2 from each seller to cover the cost of postage and an envelope for the proceeds checks and tags to be mailed to you.
- Checks and tags will be mailed to sellers approximately eight weeks after the Garage Sale.

In filling out this form and signing below, you indicate that:

- You understand that any of the shortcomings listed above and other unforeseen events may occur; you will not hold the Club responsible for unaccounted items that create a shortage in proceeds due you.
- You understand that the Club is retaining 50% of your proceeds unless you work down your donation percentage by volunteering at the Garage Sale.
- You agree that any unsold items with yellow tags will automatically be donated to a charity at the end of the sale.

Per California Vehicle Code § 27362.1 the sale of a child restraint system used during an accident is prohibited.

(a) No individual may sell or offer for sale a child passenger restraint system that was in use by a child during an accident involving a motor vehicle.

(b) A violation of this section shall be punished by a fine of one hundred dollars (\$100).

By signing below I agree that any child passenger restraint system I am selling at the MPOMC Garage Sale has NEVER been in an accident involving a motor vehicle.
